P & H NOVICE 12 CAR RALLY

Welcome to the P & H 12 Car Rally (so called because Pat & Henry Fairhead have sponsored the event for many years) - an introduction to rallying for which any standard car can be used. Only Beginners and Novices qualify for awards but everyone is welcome.

The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd. will promote a Clubsport 12 car rally on Friday 30th September 2005.

The event is a round of the SCCON 12 Car Rally Championship.

The event is open to full and associate members of SCCON.

The start venue is Honing Village Hall: Map ref. 134 / 325 277
The finish venue is Honing Village Hall: Map ref. 134 / 325 277

Petrol is not available at the start.

Scrutineering will start at: 7-00pm.
The first car will start at: 8-01pm.
Any crew not signed on by: 7-50pm will be excluded.

The route will be approximately 50 miles. A sump guard is not needed.

Timing will be by clocks held by marshals. Timing on the route will be to the previous minute.

O.S. Landranger map 134 edition D is required (the route should work on all editions back to C).

Vehicle scrutineering will take place at the start & will consist of an examination of roadworthiness and legality. e.g. Tyre tread, lights, exhaust noise, etc.

Any standard car is eligible for this event irrespective of engine size providing:

- 1) It is road legal and in good repair.
- 2) The body retains the manufacturer's profile.
- 3) It has an effective exhaust silencer.
- 4) It is painted one colour or is a colour scheme supplied by the manufacturer & carries no sign-writing or advertising.
- 5) It retains all internal trim & rear seat cushions.
- 6) It has no more than 4 forward facing lights, excluding sidelights
- 7) It carries a red warning triangle.

PENALTIES:

Missing a time control or being OTL at a time control (TC): (OTL = over total permitted lateness which shall be 30 mins at all TC's)	1 FAIL
Not presenting the correct envelope (unopened) at a TC:	1 FAIL
Wrong direction of approach to a TC:	1 FAIL
Missing or failing to record a passage check:	1 FAIL
Each minute early at a time control:	2 Mins
Each minute late at a time control:	1 Min
Failing to comply in a quiet zone: (Drive quietly with auxiliary lights off)	30 Mins
Failing to stop at any "standing give way sign" or when joining a road of higher grade or at a junction designated as a 'Give Way' by the organisers: (Competitors must stop within 2 metres before the Give Way line (or where it would be))	EXCLUSION

To qualify as a finisher, the crew must present their time card at the finish within 45 minutes of their due time at the final control.

Competitors will be entered in 4 classes: Beginner, Novice, Intermediate and Expert.

Experts and intermediates are not able to win the event. They will be classified after all Beginner and Novice crews. Classification into classes will be at the discretion of the Championship Coordinator, based on the navigator's previous experience.

Beginners will be provided with a marked map. Novices will be given the route instructions 45 minutes before their due start time (it would be advisable to arrive in good time). Intermediates and Experts will be given sealed envelopes, containing the route instructions, to be opened at specified points during the event.

SCCON championship points will be awarded as per the championship rules.

Competitors will be identified by registration plate and at Time Controls by their time cards.

Awards will be presented at the finish after the declaration of the final results and will comprise:

First Overall	P & H Trophy
Runner Up	Two Awards
Last Classified Finisher	Two Awards

The entry fee is £14-50 and does not include insurance for the event. The fee must be sent with a fully completed entry form to:

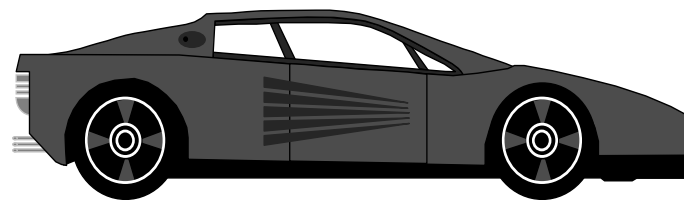
