# CANADA GARAGE 12 CAR RALLY

Welcome to the Canada Garage 12 Car Rally organised by Mark & Lorraine Annison.

The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd. will promote a Clubsport 12 car rally on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> November 2005.

The event is a round of the SCCON 12 Car Rally Championship.

The event is open to full and associate members of SCCON.

The start venue is the Blakeney Garage, Blakeney: Map ref. 133 / 026 438  
The finish venue is the Hunworth Bell PH, Hunworth: Map ref. 133 / 070 351

Petrol may be available at the start.

Scrutineering will start at: 7-00pm.  
The first car will start at: 8-01pm.  
Any crew not signed on by: 7-50pm will be excluded.

The route will be approximately 50 miles. A sump guard is not needed.

Timing will be by clocks held by marshals. Timing on the route will be to the previous minute.

O.S. Landranger maps 132 edition D & 133 edition D are required.

Vehicle scrutineering will take place at the start & will consist of an examination of roadworthiness and legality. e.g. Tyre tread, lights, exhaust noise, etc.

Any standard car is eligible for this event irrespective of engine size providing:

- 1) It is road legal and in good repair.
- 2) The body retains the manufacturer's profile.
- 3) It has an effective exhaust silencer.
- 4) It is painted one colour or is a colour scheme supplied by the manufacturer & carries no sign-writing or advertising.
- 5) It retains all internal trim & rear seat cushions.
- 6) It has no more than 4 forward facing lights, excluding sidelights
- 7) It carries a red warning triangle.

### PENALTIES:

Missing a time control or being OTL at a time control (TC): (OTL = over total permitted lateness which shall be 30 mins at all TC's)	<b>1 FAIL</b>
Not presenting the correct envelope (unopened) at a TC:	<b>1 FAIL</b>
Wrong direction of approach to a TC:	<b>1 FAIL</b>
Missing or failing to record a passage check:	<b>1 FAIL</b>
Each minute early at a time control:	<b>2 Mins</b>
Each minute late at a time control:	<b>1 Min</b>
Failing to comply in a quiet zone: (Drive quietly with auxiliary lights off)	<b>30 Mins</b>
Failing to stop at any "standing give way sign" or when joining a road of higher grade or at a junction designated as a 'Give Way' by the organisers: (Competitors must stop within 2 metres before the Give Way line (or where it would be))	<b>EXCLUSION</b>

To qualify as a finisher, the crew must present their time card at the finish within 45 minutes of their due time at the final control.

Competitors will be entered in 4 classes: Beginner, Novice, Intermediate and Expert.

Classification into classes will be at the discretion of the Championship Coordinator, based on the navigator's previous experience.

Beginners will be provided with a marked map. Novices will be given the route instructions 45 minutes before their due start time (it would be advisable to arrive in good time). Intermediates and Experts will be given sealed envelopes, containing the route instructions, to be opened at specified points during the event.

SCCON championship points will be awarded as per the championship rules.

Competitors will be identified by registration plate and at Time Controls by their time cards.

Awards will be presented at the finish after the declaration of the final results and will comprise:  
First Overall Two awards

The entry fee is £14-50 and does not include insurance for the event. The fee must be sent with a fully completed entry form to:

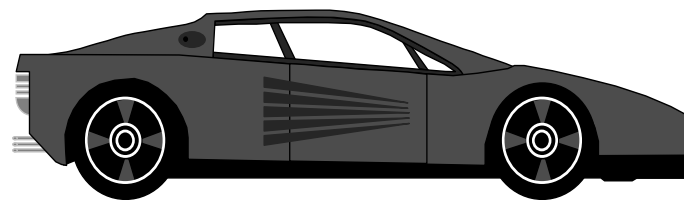
