Supplementary Regulations

1. The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd. (SCCoN) will promote a Table Top Rally lasting through autumn 2015.
2. The event will be governed by the general regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any further written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. An MSA permit is not required.
4. The event is open to anyone; membership of the organising club is not required.
5. The event may be a qualifying round of the 2015 SCCoN Clubmans Championship.
6. There is no maximum entry for the event. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations.
7. Vehicles are optional.
8. The event will take place wherever you are; it can be single or multi venue.
The total mileage will be approximately 90 miles, all official times and mileages will be deemed correct and no protests will be allowed regarding this.
Route Cards will be published in Spotlight and on the website.
9. O.S. Landranger map 144 B3 will be required.
10. There is NO Entry Fee.
11. Results will be published in 2016
12. Classes: Novice, Semi-Expert and Expert.
13. Final instructions will be published on the website and will contain a lot of explanation and much more information. It is likely that understanding the convoluted rules will be more of a challenge than solving the route cards.
14. Route Checks
 - a. Simply count the number of features passed over, under through etc ETL, Spot Heights, Bridges (Over & Under)
 - b. There will be a form to submit on the website for sending answers and asking questions – I expect more questions than answers
15. Penalties: In accordance with the Devilishly Difficult Table Top Rally Rules will use the marks system applied to scheduled timed events and will be listed in the Final Instructions.
16. Awards: At the discretion of the organisers.
17. Controls
 - a. RS Regularity Start
 - b. iRTC Intermediate Regularity Time Control
 - c. RF Regularity Finish

18. Insurance will not be required

19. Further Information.

- a. SCCoN championship points **may** be awarded as per the championship rules.
