**Can I do it?** The only navigational skill required is the ability to find your way to a map feature (church, PH, telephone box etc) in a kilometre grid square on a 1:50000 OS Landranger Map

What do I need? All Participants over 18 yrs old will need a FREE Motorsport UK RS Clubmans licence. Car (anything goes, if it is taxed and insured), OS Landranger Map(s), Pencils, Watch

Bring the family, the more eyes the better

Food will be avaliable all day at the finish If you wish to eat please book direct with the Cadogan pub Ingham mentioning SCCON. Booking early is advised as they get busy.

## Supplementary Regulations

### Article 1 - ANNOUNCEMENT

1.1 The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd will organise and promote a Clubmans Navigational Scatter on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2022 starting from Horringer Social Club, Horringer, Bury St Edmunds, IP29 5SA Map 155 / 825<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 621

#### Article 2 - JURISDICTION

2.1 The event will be governed by the general regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any further written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

#### Article 3 - AUTHORISATIONS

3.1 Motorsport UK Clubmans permit number **126299** has been issued.

#### Article 4 - ELIGIBILITY & CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 4.1 The event is open to all fully elected and associate members of the promoting club, Cambridge CC, Chelmsford MC, Harrow Car Club, Herts County Auto & Aero Club, Eastern Counties MC, Falcon MC, Green Belt MC, Kings Lynn & DMC, Middlesex County AC, West Suffolk MC and Wickford AC.
- 4.2 All drivers must produce a valid club membership card and a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman License.

#### Article 5 - TIMETABLE

5.1 Entries open on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and close on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

#### Article 6 - CLASSES

6.1 The event will consist of two classes:

T Three O One.

#### Article 7 - ROUTE & FORMAT

- 7.1 The event will start from: Horringer Social Club, Horringer, Bury St Edmunds, IP29 5SA Map 155 / 825<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 621
- 7.2 The event will finish at: The Cadogan, The Street, Ingham, Bury St Edmunds, IP31 1NG Map 155 / 8551/2 708
- 7.3 The total mileage will be approximately 30 miles.
- 7.4 Map number 155 will be required.
- 7.5 At signing on information containing Blackspots etc. will be issued. The location of the points to be visited will be issued at your start time. **Competitors will be required to visit no more than 75% of the locations.** At each location there will be two simple treasure hunt type questions to answer as proof of visiting. Question 1, worth 1 point, competitors will be able to answer without leaving the car. Question 2, worth 2 points, (at most points) competitors will be required to leave their cars and walk unspecified reasonable distances to answer. Competitors in Class O will only require answers to

the 1 point questions. Competitors in Class T will require answers to both the 1 point and 2 point questions. If there are 40 locations to visit the maximum locations that can be visited for both classes, is 30 and the maximum points possible for Class O is 30 and for class T is 90.

7.6 There will be a small number of treasures to be collected en route, these are optional and will only be used as a tie breaker.

9.1 The entry fee is £15 per car. Pay on the day: cash or cheque. Cheques should be made payable to Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd (SCCON Ltd).

- 11.3 For each tie breaker question
- 11.4 For reporting later than scheduled finish time
- 11.5 For action contrary to the spirit of the event
- 11.6 For bad driving, contravening Traffic Regulations or the Highway Code, excessive speed, excessive noiseor driving likely to bring the sport into disrepute
- 11.7 Use of satellite or GPS receiver
- 11.8 Use of the interwebby

### **Article 12 - RESULTS, TIES AND PROTESTS**

- 12.1 Interim, provisional and final results will be published on the Official Notice Board.
- 12.2 Results will be published as soon as possible after the finish of the event.
- 12.3 Ties will be resolved in accordance with M9.3.

#### **Article 13 - CLARIFICATION**
